Conservation Vision

1. PROTECT
 - the natural, cultural, geological, historical, and scenic qualities of the Sutter Buttes;
 - land capable of long-term food, fiber and/or timber production;
 - ranchlands, grazing lands and grasslands;
 - unique and/or ecologically significant natural areas, historic or cultural sites, and wildlife habitat, including riparian waterways, and threatened/endangered species;
 - land that facilitates wildlife movement, including corridors that provide connectivity between core habitat areas;
 - areas with significant scenic, educational, or recreational values;
2. IDENTIFY important farmland and natural areas that preserve and enhance the unique characteristics of our three county region;
3. PROMOTE local stewardship through public education and technical assistance to local land conservation agencies/organizations;
4. BUILD partnerships with landowners, community leaders, and developers to balance conservation with economic growth, flood protection, and water quality to help plan better communities;
